Job Summary: The Caretaker is responsible for cleaning and security at assigned properties.

Essential Job Duties:

1. Sweeps, washes, vacuums, cleans carpets, washes windows, (interior and exterior); cleans appliances, equipment, carpet and fixtures in common areas of the buildings.
2. Performs grounds maintenance, i.e., dirt, snow and ice removal from sidewalks, watering lawn and plants, trim shrubs.
3. Responds to fire, elevator and other emergency warning systems, identifies problem and reacts appropriately.
4. Responsible to coordinate repairs as needed.
5. Conducts move-in/move-out inspection at assigned properties and instructs tenants in the use of tenant-operated equipment.
6. Organizes and maintains cleaning equipment and supplies.
7. Clean units upon turnovers.

Non-Essential Job Duties:

8. Purchase supplies as needed.
