 - (i) The worker's income for the previous or annualized calendar year is below the income limit established by HUD (2023 limit \$52,400.00)
 - (ii) The worker is employed by a Section 3 business concern.
 - (iii) The worker is a YouthBuild participant.
- (2) The status of a Section 3 worker shall not be negatively affected by a prior arrest or conviction.
